About Singapore

Entry Requirements

To enter Singapore, you need a passport that is valid for at least six months beyond the date of your intended stay. If you plan on regional travel beyond Singapore, make sure that your passport is valid for at least six months beyond the date you plan to enter other countries in the region. You do not need a visa for tourist or business visits up to 90 days.

Weather

While it feels like summer pretty much all year round in Singapore, June signals the official start of the season on the calendar. This month brings more of the same steamy temperatures averaging 81°F.

About Malaysia

Entry Requirements

To enter Malaysia your passport must be valid for at least six months. You must have at least one blank page required for entry stamp.

Malaysia Weather

June falls within the dry season and features some of the greatest weather of the whole year. In June, the afternoon temperatures reach an average high of 32°C(88 F), while the nighttime temperatures range around 23°C. Both those temperatures remain perfectly constant in the course of the month.

Marina Bay Sands Hotel

Garden By The Bay



Gardens by the Bay is a nature park spanning 101 hectares of reclaimed land in the Central Region of Singapore, adjacent to the Marina Reservoir. The park consists of three waterfront gardens: Bay South Garden, Bay East Garden and Bay Central Garden

Conceptualized in 2005 as a key component of the government's "City in a

Garden" vision, which evolved from Singapore's reputation as a Garden City

Home to more than 250,000 plants, as well as pavilions, waterways and the spectacular Super Trees, Gardens by the Bay is one of Singapore's most beautiful outdoor attractions, where you can stroll leisurely through various landscapes that represent diverse ecosystems. See one of the world's tallest indoor waterfalls in the Cloud Forest conservatory, and admire views of Marina Bay from the Flower Dome conservatory.

Malacca Tour



Malacca, in southwestern Malaysia. At its center, Jonker Street, Chinatown's main thoroughfare, is known for antique shops and its night market. Nearby, the 17th-century Chinese Cheng Hoon Teng temple has ornate decorations and multiple prayer halls. A green, 3-tiered roof tops the 18th-century, Javanese-influenced Kampung Kling Mosque.

This privately guided, -day tour will take you to the most famous spots in Malacca. All of your favorite pictures you see on your friend's newsfeed will now become your reality. From beginning to the end you will be able to have a fun, stress-free day as this tour is all-inclusive to ensure you will have an unforgettable experience.

Kuala Lumpur Tour



Kuala Lumpur is the cultural, financial and economic center of Malaysia. It is also home to the Parliament of Malaysia and the official residence of the Malaysian King, the Istana Negara. The city once held the headquarters of the executive and judicial branches of the federal government, but these were relocated to Putrajaya in early 1999. However, some sections of the political bodies still remain in Kuala Lumpur.

Our Kuala Lumpur Cultural City Tour will take you to some of the most popular and culture rich spots in Kuala Lumpur. As this is a half day tour, you will be able to see Batu Caves, Independence Square, Sultan Abdul Samad building and many more top spots in a limited amount of time. Singapore Hotel | Marina Bay Sands Hotel

Offering views of the Straits of Malacca, this polished hotel near casual eateries is 3 km from the 17th-century Stadthuys in the old town, and 11 km from Malacca Airport. Featuring bold, modern decor, the fashionable rooms have Wi-Fi access and flat-screen TVs, plus minibars and safes. Some offer strait views, while suites add separate living/dining rooms. Upgraded suites come with whirlpool baths. Room service is available 24/7. There are 2 restaurants, including an Italian eatery, plus a laid-back bar. Additional amenities include a rooftop infinity pool, a sauna and a steam room, plus a gym and a playroom.

Melaka Hotel



Across a bustling road from the upscale Pavilion Kuala Lumpur shopping centre, this polished hotel is 18 km from Sultan Abdul Aziz Shah Airport and 2 km from the iconic PETRONAS Twin Towers. Refined rooms have floor-to-ceiling windows and panoramic city views, as well as free Wi-Fi, flat-screens, minibars, and tea and coffeemaking facilities. Club-level rooms add access to a lounge with complimentary breakfast and drinks. Suites come with living rooms. In-room massages and 24-hour room service are available. There's an all-day restaurant serving international cuisine, a bar and coffee lounge & a casual eatery next to an outdoor pool. Other amenities include a gym.
