Payment Arrangements

- Your \$300 deposit is due by January 10th.
- Your first monthly payment will be collected 30 days after your deposit is made or by January 15th, whichever comes first. Each of the subsequent payments will be collected every 30 days until August 15th, for a total of 8 payments(Jan-Aug).

Refund Policy

The policy is simple and one I'm sure you will find quite acceptable!

- Your deposit is fully refundable up until the day before the first monthly payment is due, which would be January 15th. 50% of your deposit can applied to a future trip within a years' time of this trip being cancelled.
- 33% of the value of your trip plus your deposit becomes non-refundable on/after March 15th.
- 66% of the value of your trip plus your deposit becomes non-refundable on/after June 15th.
- The trip becomes 100% non-refundable on/after August 15th.
- Any traveler that falls more than 2 payments behind will be removed from the trip and funds will be returned per the above refund policy. Refunds can take up to 30 days from the date requested to process.

The total cost of each add on will be divided amongst your monthly payments and you are free to add or change your add-ons right up until 1 month before departure.

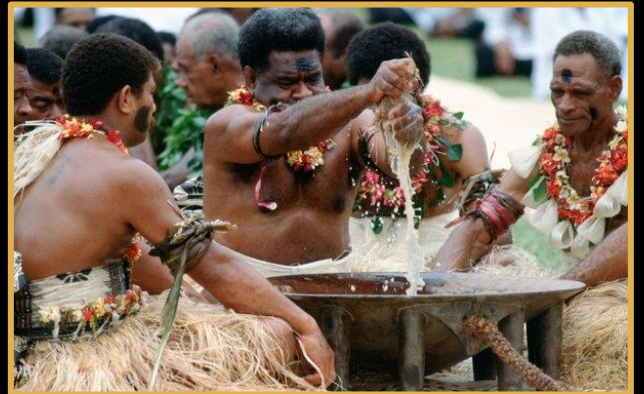
Fiji Day Tour



Your tour starts with hotel pickup by your guide for the journey to Navua, an adventure hub in Fiji. When you arrive at Pacific Harbour, board a motorboat for a ride along the Navua River, passing by villages, rainforest, gorges, farmland, rapids, and waterfalls. As you go, watch for native birds like wild ducks and heron. In about an hour, you'll reach the 'Magic Waterfall,' the tallest falls in Navua. Take a dip in the clear water underneath the cascade, and then hop on a bamboo raft for your third activity—a 30-minute ride aboard this traditional

form of travel used by past inhabitants of Fiji.

You'll arrive at a village where a Fijian warrior guides you to the bure, the meeting house. Learn about local customs and traditions, and watch a welcome ceremony known as a yagona, during which you can try kava, a drink made from the root of a plant. Hear about the village's history, founded in the early 1800s, and then watch a war dance and feel free to join in the snake dance, if you wish. Test your skills at painting on traditional fabric, and observe local women braiding mats before enjoying your lovo lunch, which consists of fish, meat, and vegetables such as wild yams, wrapped in banana leaves and baked underground. Fruit and salad accompany your meal. When you're done eating, your driver takes you back to your hotel for drop-off.



Meke Lovo Cultural Show & Dinner



Experience the warmth of the friendly Fijian people and take in the spirited Fijian music and dance performance, known as the Meke dance. Then, witness the mystic gift of walking barefoot on hot rocks and coming out unscathed, a legend your host for the evening will enlighten you with. Enjoy the feast which includes a kava tasting ceremony and lovo style cooking, where food is cooked in an underground hot rock oven.

Island Hopping Tour



Your tour starts after being transferred to the island of Mana. From there you will be taken to Modriki island onboard an 80 ft yacht, stopping along the way for snorkeling and to visit many of the nearby deserted islands. After Modriki, we head to Yanuya Island. On Yanuya you will visit a traditional Fijian island village. You'll be welcomed ashore with a Kava ceremony, have the chance to explore the village and meet the locals.

Modriki (pronounced 'Mon-driki') is a pristine little haven. The sand is vividly white, and the water is the clearest blue you can imagine. The island was made famous in year 2000 when 'Cast Away', the Hollywood block-buster movie starring Tom Hanks, was released. Modriki is the island at which the movie was filmed, and although Tom's character just wanted to escape Modriki, the last thing you'll want to do is leave!



When you step ashore at Yanuya, your smile will just grow wider as you meet the local villagers. This Mamanuca Island is home to a traditional Fiji Island village. The villagers welcome Seaspray guests with a Kava ceremony so you'll be able to try some kava if you wish and then chat to the locals as you browse their handicraft.

Shark Snorkeling



You'll start your day cruising through the Mamanuca Islands and then onto the stunning more isolated Yasawas Islands, here you'll disembark at Kuata Island, the closest of the Yasawa Islands to Nadi. Kuata Island is a hidden small gem in the Yasawa Island archipelago. A picture postcard beach, transparent turquoise waters, unusual tall rock formations and that same warm hospitality synonymous with Fijian people. There's small rustic accommodation on Kuata Island offering a Robinson Crusoe style experience with the comforts of a restaurant, bar, hammocks and even a swimming pool!

Following your briefing on the Kuata Island beachfront you'll board a boat together with your guides and travel to our snorkeling with sharks reef site. Departure time varies depending on tidal and sea conditions. You won't go hungry with morning tea & afternoon tea and lunch all served on Kuata Island. For the remainder of the day the facilities of Barefoot Kuata are available to you. There's good snorkelling close to the beachfront, kayaks, walking tracks and even a massage service available at an additional cost.

Zip Lining & Mud Bath

Upon arrival, listen to an orientation and watch a safety demonstration. Get fitted for a helmet and harness by your experienced adventure guides, then begin your adventure. The course involves some challenging trekking between the 16 lines, and is only suitable for those in good physical condition. Clip in and zoom off through the forests, caves and canyons. Get panoramic ocean views from the course, composed of lines over 3 miles (5km) long. After your adventure, sit down to a Filippino-style chicken kaldereta lunch, accompanied by water or a soft drink. Vegetarian options are provided on request. Back into the tour vehicle, travel about 40 minutes to the hot springs and mud pools. Change into your swimwear and step into the thick mud pools, coat yourself in the healing mud, and then lie in the sun to let it dry. Rinse off and head to the hot springs for a relaxing spa bath; pools range in temperature from warm to very hot. Opt to hire a therapist for a traditional Fijian massage.



5 Day Extension in Vanuatu



Your tour begins with pickup from your Port Vila hotel or cruise port in time for an 8.30am departure. Traveling aboard a comfortable air-conditioned tour bus, set out to explore the island, starting with a visit to Iarofa Village. Enjoy a thrilling introduction to island culture as you meet the locals and watch an impressive display of traditional dancing and fire walking. Continue to Eton Village, where you'll gain a greater inside into local life and perhaps get chance to visit the village primary school (depending on opening times). After strolling around the village, relax on the white sands of Eton Beach, or dive in to cool off with a swim in the Blue Lagoon. Pass through Pangpang, stopping to admire the gigantic ancient banyan trees, before arriving at Takara Lodge in time for lunch. Tuck into a delicious buffet lunch as you listen to live music from a local band, then relax and unwind in the natural hot springs. In the afternoon, learn more about the island's history as you visit some of the island's World War II sites, then take in the views from Gideon's Landing. Finally, pay a visit to the Survivor Beach, so-called as it was the filming location for the 'Survivor Vanuatu - Islands of Fire' TV series. Here, you'll have chance to swim, snorkel, and enjoy afternoon tea.
