About Bali

Entry Requirements

You must have a valid passport and an onward/return ticket for tourist/business "visa free" stays of up to 30 days. Your passport must be valid for the entire time you are staying in Japan.

Weather

The average temperature in June is 27°C (80°F), while the average low is 22°C (72°F), and the average high comes in at 31°C (88°F).

About Singapore

Entry Requirements

To enter Singapore, you need a passport that is valid for at least six months beyond the date of your intended stay. If you plan on regional travel beyond Singapore, make sure that your passport is valid for at least six months beyond the date you plan to enter other countries in the region. You do not need a visa for tourist or business visits up to 90 days.

Weather

While it feels like summer pretty much all year round in Singapore, June signals the official start of the season on the calendar. This month brings more of the same steamy temperatures averaging 81°F.

About Malaysia

Entry Requirements

To enter Malaysia your passport must be valid for at least six months. You must have at least one blank page required for entry stamp.

Malaysia Weather

June falls within the dry season and features some of the greatest weather of the whole year. In June, the afternoon temperatures reach an average high of 32°C (88 F), while the nighttime temperatures range around 23°C. Both those temperatures remain perfectly constant in the course of the month.

Uluwatu & Kecak Dance Tour

Uluwatu Temple Sunset Tour with Kecak Dance and Candlelight Dinner is the most popular half day tour of Bali, that take you to discover an amazing temple of Pura Luhur Uluwatu.

The temple perched on top of a steep cliff approximately 70 metres above sea level, which is one of the top places on the island to go to for sunset delights, with direct views overlooking the beautiful Indian Ocean.

Beside experience the magnificent views is your opportunity to watch a mesmerizing performance of a Kecak dance performance at Uluwatu Temple with a shimmering Indian Ocean sunset as your backdrop.



Temples, Waterfalls & Monkey Forest Tour

This privately guided, full-day tour, will take you to some of the coolest spots in Ubud and Canggu. You will have a chance to play with the monkeys, visit the famous Tanah Lot Temple and more! From beginning to the end you will be able to have a fun, stress-free day as this tour is all-inclusive to ensure you will have an unforgettable experience.



Tirta Empul temple is a Hindu Balinese water temple located near the town of Tampaksiring, Bali, Indonesia. The temple compound consists of a petirtaan or bathing structure, famous for its holy spring water, where Balinese Hindus go to for ritual purification.

Mandala Suci Wenara Wana, or well known as **Monkey Forest**, is the sanctuary and natural habitat of the Balinese long-tailed Monkey, scientific name *Macaca fascicularis*. It is located at Padangtegal Ubud, Bali. About 749 monkeys live in this sanctuary.





Kanto Lampo Waterfall referred to by locals as Air Terjun Kanto Lampo. This is a hidden gem in Bali where you can soak in the pristine water, and take pictures on the insta-famous rock. Hidden deep in the jungles of Gianyar region, Kanto Lampo Waterfall can be a great sight for exploration. This scenic, seasonal waterfall with its water cascading down a stepped rock formation is a stunning view to behold. Located in the village of Beng Gianyar, this

waterfall is also very easy to get to. Unlike other waterfalls, you don't have to go through miles and miles of hiking and trekking.

Within 15 minutes, you will reach the spot of the waterfall. The slightly under the radar location of Kanto Lampo adds to its uniqueness. The source of water unlike other waterfalls in the Bali region is a dam and this waterfall is absolutely new. But this formation of a new waterfall turned out to be a boon for the local villagers. As many tourists keep coming to visit this waterfall, the income of the villagers increases somewhat. If you are a photography enthusiast, you can climb up the rocks on the top of the waterfall and get some nice, instagram worthy pictures.

Pura **Tanah Lot** is a hugely popular tourist destination. It does have cultural significance to the Balinese, but this can be hard to discern amid the crowds, clamour and chaos – especially for the overhyped sunsets. It's the most visited and photographed temple in Bali; however, it has all the authenticity of a stage set – even the tower of rock that the temple sits upon is an artful reconstruction (the entire structure was crumbling) and more than one-third of the rock is artificial.

Pura Penataran Agung Lempuyang is a Balinese Hindu temple or pura located in the slope of Mount Lempuyang in Karangasem, Bali. Pura Penataran Agung Lempuyang is considered as part of a complex of pura surrounding Mount Lempuyang, one of the highly regarded temples of Bali.



Tirta Gangga Water Palace also known locally as Taman Tirta Gangga, is a former water palace of Karangasem empire which one of east Bali's most famous sights. Situated about 6 kilometres north of the town of Amlapura, which feature 1.2ha of pools, ponds and fountains surrounded by tropical gardens. Breathtaking scenery with lush rice paddies back three levels of ornamental gardens with swimming pools, fountains, stone carvings, stepping stones,

fish ponds, and airy pavilions.

The Tirta Gangga literally means water from the Ganges (India's holy Ganges River) and it is a site of some reverence for the Hindu Balinese. Strictly, the name refers to the water palace built here from the late 1940's to the 1950's by Gusti Gede Djelantik, heir to the former Kingdom of Karangasem. The centerpiece of the palace is an eleven tiered fountain and there are many beautiful carvings and statues adorning the gardens.

The stunning Tukad Cepung cave waterfall is one of the best waterfalls in Bali, Indonesia. On sunny days light rays stream into the cave, illuminating the waterfall in an almost magical fashion. Although Tukad Cepung is a relatively well hidden waterfall, in recent years it has become something of an Instagram hotspot thanks to its unique location. It's a truly beautiful spot that is a worthy inclusion on any Bali itinerary.





Tegalalang rice fields is a series of rice paddies located close to Ubud, in the centre of Bali, famous for its terraced layout. This is a traditional Balinese irrigation system known as subak. Positioned in a valley the Tegalalang rice terraces offer extremely scenic lookouts over the rice fields and surrounding green landscape. It's a very popular tourist hotspot in Bali and a must-see in many Bali itineraries.

Free yourself from your fear of heights and ride the famous **swing in Bali** against a stunning jungle backdrop! Beginner level 1- fundamental basics, surf safety & awareness (hazards), learning about the surf equipment, board characteristics, stand up technique, position on the board, catching the wave. Suitable for first timers or guests that have surfed before but want to learn the correct technique.

Beginner level 2- build on the basics & confidence, paddling out & in, board control, start front & back side turns in the white wash, begin working on timing & take offs on small green waves. Suitable for guests who can catch small broken waves without help & can consistently stand up with good balance.

Beginner level 3- paddle out to the line up to catch green waves, learn about wave selection, techniques to paddle out (eskimo roll), importance of position to catch a wave, improve timing & take off, work on turns & trims along the face of the wave. Suitable for surfers who can perform front & back side turns occasionally & need to improve timing/take off/wave selection/reading the surf.

Intermediate level- building confidence on more challenging waves, wave selection, reading the surf, refining take off, generating speed, climb & drop the waves face. Suitable for surfers who are comfortable riding small green waves, able to do front & back side trims across the wave face, unable to do bottom & top turns, inconsistent with take offs on larger waves.
