Payment Arrangements

- Your \$200 deposit is due June 20th.
- Your first monthly payment will be collected 30 days after your deposit is made or by June 30th whichever comes first. Each of the subsequent payments will be collected every 30 days until May 30th, for a total of 12 payments (June – May)

Refund/Cancellation Policy

- Your deposit is fully refundable for 15 days after it has been paid, or until June 30th, whichever comes first.
- 50% of your deposit can be applied to a future trip within a years' time of this trip being cancelled.
- Each monthly payment becomes non-refundable 30 days after the due date for that payment.
- The trip becomes 100% non-refundable on/after May 30th.
- All trips are non-transferrable
- Refunds can take up to 30 days from the date it is requested.

Uluwatu & Kecak Dance Tour

Uluwatu Temple Sunset Tour with Kecak Dance and Candlelight Dinner is the most popular half day tour of Bali, that take you to discover an amazing temple of Pura Luhur Uluwatu.

The temple perched on top of a steep cliff approximately 70 metres above sea level, which is one of the top places on the island to go to for sunset delights, with direct views overlooking the beautiful Indian Ocean.

Beside experience the magnificent views is your opportunity to watch a mesmerizing performance of a Kecak dance performance at Uluwatu Temple with a shimmering Indian Ocean sunset as your backdrop.



Temples, Waterfalls & Monkey Forest Tour

This privately guided, full-day tour, will take you to some of the coolest spots in Ubud and Canggu. You will have a chance to play with the monkeys, visit the famous Tanah Lot Temple and more! From beginning to the end you will be able to have a fun, stress-free day as this tour is all-inclusive to ensure you will have an unforgettable experience.



Tirta Empul temple is a Hindu Balinese water temple located near the town of Tampaksiring, Bali, Indonesia. The temple compound consists of a petirnaan or bathing structure, famous for its holy spring water, where Balinese Hindus go to for ritual purification.

Mandala Suci Wenara Wana, or well known as **Monkey Forest**, is the sanctuary and natural habitat of the Balinese long-tailed Monkey, scientific name *Macaca fascicularis*. It is located at Padangtegal Ubud, Bali. About 749 monkeys live in this sanctuary.





Kanto Lampo Waterfall referred to by locals as Air Terjun Kanto Lampo. This is a hidden gem in Bali where you can soak in the pristine water, and take pictures on the insta-famous rock. Hidden deep in the jungles of Gianyar region, Kanto Lampo Waterfall can be a great sight for exploration. This scenic, seasonal waterfall with its water cascading down a stepped rock formation is a stunning view to behold. Located in the village of Beng Gianyar, this

waterfall is also very easy to get to. Unlike other waterfalls, you don't have to go through miles and miles of hiking and trekking.

Within 15 minutes, you will reach the spot of the waterfall. The slightly under the radar location of Kanto Lampo adds to its uniqueness. The source of water unlike other waterfalls in the Bali region is a dam and this waterfall is absolutely new. But this formation of a new waterfall turned out to be a boon for the local villagers. As many tourists keep coming to visit this waterfall, the income of the villagers increases somewhat. If you are a photography enthusiast, you can climb up the rocks on the top of the waterfall and get some nice, instagram worthy pictures.

Pura **Tanah Lot** is a hugely popular tourist destination. It does have cultural significance to the Balinese, but this can be hard to discern amid the crowds, clamour and chaos – especially for the overhyped sunsets. It's the most visited and photographed temple in Bali; however, it has all the authenticity of a stage set – even the tower of rock that the temple sits upon is an artful reconstruction (the entire structure was crumbling) and more than one-third of the rock is artificial.



Even More Temples, Waterfalls and Swings Tour

Pura Penataran Agung Lempuyang is a Balinese Hindu temple or pura located in the slope of Mount Lempuyang in Karangasem, Bali. Pura Penataran Agung Lempuyang is considered as part of a complex of pura surrounding Mount Lempuyang, one of the highly regarded temples of Bali.



Tirta Gangga Water Palace also known locally as Taman Tirta Gangga, is a former water palace of Karangasem empire which one of east Bali's most famous sights. Situated about 6 kilometres north of the town of Amlapura, which feature 1.2ha of pools, ponds and fountains surrounded by tropical gardens. Breathtaking scenery with lush rice paddies back three levels of ornamental gardens with swimming pools, fountains, stone carvings, stepping stones,

fish ponds, and airy pavilions.

The Tirta Gangga literally means water from the Ganges (India's holy Ganges River) and it is a site of some reverence for the Hindu Balinese. Strictly, the name refers to the water palace built here from the late 1940's to the 1950's by Gusti Gede Djelantik, heir to the former Kingdom of Karangasem. The centerpiece of the palace is an eleven tiered fountain and there are many beautiful carvings and statues adorning the gardens.

The stunning Tukad Cepung cave waterfall is one of the best waterfalls in Bali, Indonesia. On sunny days light rays stream into the cave, illuminating the waterfall in an almost magical fashion. Although Tukad Cepung is a relatively well hidden waterfall, in recent years it has become something of an Instagram hotspot thanks to its unique location. It's a truly beautiful spot that is a worthy inclusion on any Bali itinerary.





Tegalalang rice fields is a series of rice paddies located close to Ubud, in the centre of Bali, famous for its terraced layout. This is a traditional Balinese irrigation system known as subak. Positioned in a valley the Tegalalang rice terraces offer extremely scenic lookouts over the rice fields and surrounding green landscape. It's a very popular tourist hotspot in Bali and a must-see in many Bali itineraries.

Singapore & Malaysia

Marina Bay Sands Hotel

Garden By The Bay



Gardens by the Bay is a nature park spanning 101 hectares of reclaimed land in the Central Region of Singapore, adjacent to the Marina Reservoir. The park consists of three waterfront gardens: Bay South Garden, Bay East Garden and Bay Central Garden

Conceptualized in 2005 as a key component of the government's "City in a

Garden" vision, which evolved from Singapore's reputation as a Garden City

Home to more than 250,000 plants, as well as pavilions, waterways and the spectacular Super Trees, Gardens by the Bay is one of Singapore's most beautiful outdoor attractions, where you can stroll leisurely through various landscapes that represent diverse ecosystems. See one of the world's tallest indoor waterfalls in the Cloud Forest conservatory, and admire views of Marina Bay from the Flower Dome conservatory.

Malacca Tour



Malacca, in southwestern Malaysia. At its center, Jonker Street, Chinatown's main thoroughfare, is known for antique shops and its night market. Nearby, the 17th-century Chinese Cheng Hoon Teng temple has ornate decorations and multiple prayer halls. A green, 3-tiered roof tops the 18th-century, Javanese-influenced Kampung Kling Mosque.
