Payment Arrangements

- ullet Your \$200 deposit is due by December $14^{
 m th}$
- Your first monthly payment will be collected 30 days after your deposit is made or by December 30th whichever comes first. Each of the subsequent payments will be collected every 30 days until May 30th, for a total of 6 payments (Dec May).

Refund Policy

- · Your deposit is fully refundable for 15 days after it has been paid, or until December 30th, whichever comes first. 50% of your deposit can applied to a future trip within a years' time of this trip being cancelled.
- · Each monthly payment becomes non-refundable 30 days after the due date for that payment.
- · The trip becomes 100% non-refundable on/after May 30th
- · Refunds can take up to 30 days from the date requested to process.

Traveling Alone?

While the option is there for you to get a single occupancy room if you choose, by no means do you have to select it if trave ling alone. We understand that the extra money spent in getting your own room, takes away from the money available to you to splurge on the streets of Singapore.

For that reason, we extend each traveler the option of having us pair you with a suitable roommate for no additional cost. Roommates are paired based upon the answers to their personality questions on their registration form, as well as their ages and even astrological signs. At least 2 months before departure you will be given the contact information of your roommate, giving each of you the opportunity to get properly acquainted.

About Singapore

Entry Requirements

To enter Singapore, you need a passport that is valid for at least six months beyond the date of your intended stay. If you plan on regional travel beyond Singapore, make sure that your passport is valid for at least six months beyond the date you plan to enter other countries in the region. You do not need a visa for tourist or business visits up to 90 days.

Weather

While it feels like summer pretty much all year round in Singapore, June signals the official start of the season on the calendar. This month brings more of the same steamy temperatures averaging 81°F.

About Malaysia

Entry Requirements

To enter Malaysia your passport must be valid for at least six months. You must have at least one blank page required for entry stamp.

Malaysia Weather

June falls within the dry season and features some of the greatest weather of the whole year. In June, the afternoon temperatures reach an average high of 32°C (88 F), while the nighttime temperatures range around 23°C. Both those temperatures remain perfectly constant in the course of the month.

Marina Bay Sands Hotel



Set in 3 ultra-modern buildings overlooking Marina Bay, this posh hotel is across the road from luxe stores at The Shoppes and 2 minutes' walk from Bayfront MRT station.

Featuring floor-to-ceiling windows with city or bay views, the warm, airy rooms offer minibars, free Wi-Fi and flat-screens. Family rooms include living areas, Nespresso machines and balconies. Garden By The Bay



Gardens by the Bay is a nature park spanning 101 hectares of reclaimed land in the Central Region of Singapore, adjacent to the Marina Reservoir. The park consists of three waterfront gardens: Bay South Garden, Bay East Garden and Bay Central Garden

Conceptualized in 2005 as a key component of the government's "City in a

Garden" vision, which evolved from Singapore's reputation as a Garden City

Home to more than 250,000 plants, as well as pavilions, waterways and the spectacular Super Trees, Gardens by the Bay is one of Singapore's most beautiful outdoor attractions, where you can stroll leisurely through various landscapes that represent diverse ecosystems. See one of the world's tallest indoor waterfalls in the Cloud Forest conservatory, and admire views of Marina Bay from the Flower Dome conservatory.

Malacca Tour



Malacca, in southwestern Malaysia. At its center, Jonker Street, Chinatown's main thoroughfare, is known for antique shops and its night market. Nearby, the 17th-century Chinese Cheng Hoon Teng temple has ornate decorations and multiple prayer halls. A green, 3-tiered roof tops the 18th-century, Javanese-influenced Kampung Kling Mosque.

Kuala Lumpur is the cultural, financial and economic center of Malaysia. It is also home to the Parliament of Malaysia and the official residence of the Malaysian King, the Istana Negara. The city once held the headquarters of the executive and judicial branches of the federal government, but these were relocated to Putrajaya in early 1999. However, some sections of the political bodies still remain in Kuala Lumpur.
